Jesus says: I am the light of the world; whoever believes in me has the light of everlasting life.


Dear Parishioners,

From the report to our Parish Councils:

- The Covid pandemic and the effects of lockdowns have dominated this last year.
- Many aspects of church life have been prevented or reduced by the restrictions on movement. This is especially marked in the liturgical and social life of the parishes.
- Restrictions have also affected our contacts with the sick and vulnerable, our meetings to organise the running and maintenance of the parishes, and the faith development of the parishes.
- IN SPITE OF all these difficulties the running of the parish and the life of faith has continued, and indeed developed in certain ways.
- We have followed the principles during the pandemic of keep Faith, keep Contact and keep Charity.
