PALM SUNDAY – HOLY WEEK : 28th March 2021



- Holy Week is the most sacred week of the year.
- We accompany Jesus with His disciples through His passion and His death to rejoice with Him in His resurrection.

- Every Catholic should strive to attend all the parts of Holy Week.
- **'Triduum'** means 'Three Days'. (From Holy Thursday). These days are the centre of our Christian faith.
- Our Lord claimed that the truth would be revealed when, after his execution, He would rise again.
- He said it and did it. Therefore our faith, which we hold in its fullness as Catholics, is true.

Covid Restrictions and the Triduum:

- We celebrate with joy and faith the sacred liturgy. But:
- NO processions, holding candles or palms, sprinkling with Holy Water, Easter Fire, and individual veneration of the Cross; blessed palms and small containers of the blessed Easter water will be available.
- All liturgies will be broadcasted as shown.

MAUNDY THURSDAY

Evening Mass of the Lords Supper at 7.00pm, Grange.

- We become present at the Last Supper, when Our Lord summed up his self-sacrifice in a sacred meal, the Mass.



- We also receive from Bishop Paul the Holy Oils that will be used in the coming year.
- Mgr Slattery, Fr. Parker and Fr. Philip will solemnly renew their priestly commitment to serve their people at this Mass.
- There will be no **watching at the Altar of Repose** under covid regulations.



GOOD FRIDAY

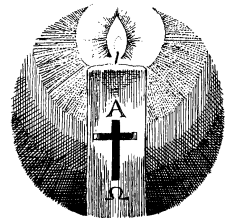
- **Solemn Liturgy of the Passion and Death of Our Lord** at 3.00pm, at both Grange and Milnthorpe. We walk with Our Lord to his execution, sorrowing that the sins of the world should require such loving self-sacrifice.
- Good Friday **stations of the cross** (Grange 11am) (also broadcasted).

- **HOLY SATURDAY DAY:** We watch and wait in quiet, preparing for the resurrection.

Easter

HOLY SATURDAY Easter Vigil 8.00pm, Milnthorpe.

- This is mother of all vigils, the centre of the Christian year.
- The light of Christ comes into our world.
- We travel through history of the Old Testament. God reveals Himself as the saving God.
- Finally God comes personally in Jesus, the one who 'broke the chains of death and rose triumphant from the grave' (Exultet)
- (Easter Day Masses at Grange 9.00am and Arnside 11.00am)
