Next phase of Covid 19 guidance for Mass– from 1st August 2021

It will no longer be necessary to book a place at Mass at Christ the King. We will not be formally organising seating.

[Please note, this is not the case in our other churches.]

Please do the following:

- **Sign In:** You are urged to sign in or use NHS app (see below *)
- **Sanitise Hands:** Use the hand sanitiser on arrival.
- **Maintain Distance.** We will continue to use alternate benches, and ask you individually to be aware of distance within the benches.
- **Face Mask:** Wear a face mask when moving particularly when going to communion; *however, you may remove it when seated, if wished.* Please be considerate to the needs of people near to you.
- **Singing:** You may now sing, but only if wearing a mask. You may also use a hymnbook, if you wish. Please do not share a hymnbook.
- **Communion Procession:** We will continue to steward the Communion procession.
- **No Chalice Yet:** Communion will continue to be only under one kind; there will no sharing of the chalice.

* Special note: Signing In

It is no longer mandatory to provide contact details for tracing. This is causing considerable confusion. At this point we have decided the following:

To simplify and speed 'check in' for those who wish to continue to do this, we have made a list of those who attended Mass fairly regularly over these last months. The list is on the hallway table; please tick your name to denote your presence at Mass. *We will not remind you to do this, or do it on your behalf.*

If you wish to remove your name from this list, or add your name to the list, please do. The list will be kept for 3 weeks, as previously.

If you wish to use the App, please do.
